

## We Wai Kai Citizens Assembly / Nation Community Meeting November 18-19, 2023

As our Citizens Assembly and Community Meeting is fast approaching, our team would like to share meeting details so that you can solidify your plans.

Both meetings will be at the Quinsam Hall in Campbell River. On November 18<sup>th</sup>, registration/sign-in will start at 8:00 am and the meeting will begin at 9:00 am until approximately 4:30 pm, followed by dinner at 5:00 pm. November 19<sup>th</sup> will consist of the Nation's Community meeting and should be wrapped up by early afternoon. We are still developing the agenda's and the meeting packages and we will share it with you once finalized.

The team really would appreciate your pre-registration so that we can plan accordingly. The cut-off date for pre-registration is <u>Oct 20<sup>th</sup> at 4:00</u>. A travel subsidy will be available for our Members who live outside of the Campbell River area. The maximum subsidy is calculated on the roundtrip kilometres from your residence to Campbell River. Additional details of the subsidy is provided in this package.

This year our evening entertainment will be a community bingo. We have some great door prizes for the meeting portion and the bingo session. The prizes are so good that we have added some rules:

- Pre-registration will get you 1 ticket for the grand prize.
- You have to be present to win the grand prize and the door prizes.
- We will hand out 1 ticket to everyone who is at the meeting and it will be done at a specific time. That time will be a secret.
- The door prizes will be drawn randomly throughout the meeting.
- Once you win a door prize, your name will be removed from the draw for any more door prizes but it will be added to the grand prize draw.

This means that if you pre-register and are at the meeting when tickets are distributed you have a chance to have your name in the draw for the grand prize **two times**. Pre-registration is important because we are able to plan our meeting accordingly and to ensure that we have enough food for everyone that attends.

# WE WAI KAI TREATY SOCIETY CITIZENS' ASSEMBLY INFORMATION AND REGISTRATION / TRAVEL SUBSIDY FORM November 18, 2023 at Quinsam Hall

The Citizens Assembly is open to registered band members of the We Wai Kai First Nation.

- Only registered band members will be subsidized, cheques will be issued for your reimbursement.
- If other registered band members are travelling together only one member will receive the subsidy.
- Cheques will be issued for travel, your registration form and <u>travel claim will need to be submitted by OCTOBER 20<sup>th</sup> at 4:00 to guarantee your cheque will be ready for you at the assembly. We will make best efforts to have late registrations and travel claims available but cannot guarantee it will be ready.</u>

Please make your own travel arrangements, budget accordingly, and keep all original receipts. Local hotels are and some offer "First Nations rates" so ensure that you ask when making your reservation:

Up to 3 nights for hotel will be subsidized and fall in line with the following pay structure:

\*50km to 700km- \$1200 max

\*701-1000 km- \$1450 max

\*1001 km + -\$1600 max

- Treasury Board rates will be used for mileage (\$.55)
- For ferry travel, we encourage you to make reservations, prepay, and submit the receipt with your registration. If you choose to travel without a reservation you will need to submit your 1 way receipt, however your reimbursement will include the roundtrip cost as long as your travel falls within the pay structure above.
- Ferry costs will be reimbursed for Cape Mudge residents.
- For hotel and flight, reimbursement please attach your reservation to the registration form.
