The We Wai Kai Treaty Society is please to offer 4 educational scholarships to deserving We Wai Kai Nation students who are in financial need and who demonstrate merit.

Application Deadline: June 30, 2024, 2023 4:00 pm

Note: that all supporting material and the completed application form must be received by June 30, 2024 at 4:00PM (PDT). **Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.**

ELIGIBLE RECIPIENTS

The Society will grant scholarships only to persons who:

- Are members of the We Wai Kai First Nation;
- Are enrolled at an eligible post-secondary educational institution as a full-time student;
- Are pursuing studies that lead to a degree or to a certificate or diploma from that institution; and
- Are in financial need and demonstrate merit.

Preference will be given to candidates who wish to pursue and excel in academic pursuits with the greatest potential benefit to the welfare and advancement of aboriginal communities and causes.

Examples of Ineligible Fields of Study:

- Conferences / symposiums / workshops
- Professional Fees / schools
- Education at non-recognized post-secondary institutions
- Executive / Management programs
- Fine Arts programs

APPLICATIONS

Scholarship Applications will be reviewed at least once per year by the Board or by a committee formed for the purpose of making scholarship recommendations to the Board.
